



## With the new capabilities of your remote key fob extra care must be observed.

To avoid risk of death, injury, entrapment or property damage:

**NEVER** operate the convertible top remotely without a competent adult observing the convertible top operation.

**ALWAYS** keep body parts and interfering objects away form the moving convertible top and windows.

**NEVER** operate the convertible top remotely around infants, children or pets or others with impaired vision or judgment.

**NEVER** allow infants, children, pets or those with impaired vision or judgment to handle or have access to the remote control.

**NEVER** depend solely on the stop and reverse features of the remote control to avoid death, injury or property damage.

**NEVER** leave children or pets unattended or in a closed vehicle.

**ALWAYS** store your remote control key fob in such a way that the buttons will not accidently get pressed.

ALWAYS provide these safety warnings to any operator of the vehicle remote control.

**ALWAYS** immediately remove the remote top controller from the vehicle (remove the door panel, remove the four Philips screws in the case and unplug the unit from cable), in the event a malfunction of the remote top controller product is observed.
